

FACULTY OF ECONOMICS

The university's Faculty of Economics, which has been awarded the Higher Education Quality Award by the Ministry of Education, has 8 bachelor's and 9 master's programmes – 3 of them in English – and a doctoral school in a multi-cycle linear training system. Thanks to this, the Faculty has the most versatile training programme of all the national higher educational institutions offering economics courses.

As the educational programmes have been co-ordinated, the courses are adaptable and movement between them can be made easily, providing students with diverse opportunities for specialisation. There are many special courses available in foreign languages with native tutors, and the Faculty provides its students with flexible professional practical experience, placing great emphasis on developing outstanding talents in its established organisations including Harsányi János Professional College or the Higher Education Enterprise Development Centre.

The Faculty of Economics regularly participates in international research with the University of Darmstadt, PSA Peugeot Citroen, the German-Hungarian Chamber of Trade and Industry and The University of California in San Diego, among many others. It is also home to the Hungarian Academy of Sciences Regional Innovation and Science of Evolutionism Network Research Group.

The Faculty was the first to appear on all the social networks most commonly used by Hungarian youth, thus having a presence on iwiw, Facebook, YouTube, Flickr and Twitter pages. New functions are continually being introduced and reported on the Faculty's blog, which students use and may forward.

In addition to a colourful student life, the Faculty also plays an active role in the life of Veszprém city, constantly cooperating with the Veszprém Street Music Festival. The Faculty has its own stage and organises various programmes and interactive promotions at this event. The Pannon Family Board Games are traditionally held at the Gizella Days Festival, as is the Economic Games Festival on Researchers' Night. To fulfil its social responsibilities the Faculty collects donations for the needy at Christmas, and together with students and tutors it has adopted a meerkat family at the zoo.

Collaborating with and being in line with the requirements of companies in the Central Transdanubian and Western Pannon Regions, the University of Pannonia Faculty of Economics successfully promotes the realisation of regional, national and cross-border educational, research and development programmes.
